**Medicaid**

Medicaid is a program that pays for covered medical and health care costs of people who qualify. A wide range of medical and health care services are available through the Medicaid program. These services are covered only if they are medically necessary. Medicaid recipients can make choices about doctors, dentists, pharmacies, and other providers of services. Medicaid is available to certain low-income people. You must meet one of the following criteria in order to qualify for Medicaid.

- A child under age 21;
- A parent living with a child under age 18;
- A woman who is pregnant;
- A woman who needs treatment for breast or cervical cancer and who has been diagnosed through the Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program;
- A person who is aged (over 65);
- A person who is blind or disabled;
- Certain Medicare beneficiaries; or
- A person who is disabled and working.

**Find a Dentist Who Provides Services to Individuals on Medicaid**

Iowa Medicaid Enterprise's website provides a list of dentists who provide services to individuals on Medicaid. If you do not have access to the Internet at home, many public libraries have computers that members of the public can use to access the Internet. Following are instructions for how to search for a dentist:

1. Go to [www.ime.state.ia.us](http://www.ime.state.ia.us)
2. Click on "Providers"
3. In the "Provider Tools and Resources" section on the right of the page, click on "Search for a Provider"
4. Use the drop down box called "Specialty" and change the selection to "Dentist"
5. You can then search for dentists in your county or metro area

## **Iowa Dental Wellness Plan**

The Dental Wellness Plan provides dental benefits for **adults** ages 19 to 64 that have incomes between 0 and 133% of the federal poverty level and are not currently covered under Medicaid.

### ***hawk-I—Iowa***

**hawk-i** is health care coverage for uninsured **children** of working families. No family pays more than \$20 per month for coverage and some families pay nothing at all. Children from families making \$50,000 or less each year may qualify. **hawk-i** is different than Medicaid because it covers children only up to age 19 and services are limited. Dental Lifeline of Iowa provides comprehensive treatment to qualified individuals by licensed dentists in the State of Iowa. Patients are eligible if they lack adequate income to pay for dental care AND have a permanent disability, or who are age 65 or older, or who qualify as medically fragile.

## **Smiles Change Lives - Orthodontics**

Smiles Change Lives (SCL) connects caring orthodontic providers with qualified children ages 10-18 who are in need of braces. Approved families agree to pay a \$600 program fee for access to SCL's provider network. SCL orthodontic providers offer quality treatment and healthy smiles to children approved for our program. Youth applying for our program must meet certain guidelines and be motivated to follow their orthodontist's treatment plan, which averages between 20 and 36 months.

**NOTE:** Youth already wearing braces are not eligible for the program.
